Affiliate	Entry level grade. Suitable for newcomers to FM, suppliers working within the industry, or anyone with an interest in the FM industry who is not pursuing professional development or qualifications as a practising facilities manager. Previous experience in facilities management is not required.	No assessment required.	
Associate	Route (a) Two years facilities management experience at non-managerial level. Route (b) One year FM experience and FM-related qualifications at NZQA Level 4.	Please submit CV and qualification certificate as relevant.	AFMANZ
Member	Route (a) Three years managerial experience in addition to two years in FM, plus an NZQA L5 Diploma. Route (b) At least one year managerial experience in addition to one year in FM, plus an NZQA L6 Degree. Route (c) Three years managerial experience in addition to two years in FM, as well as an FM qualification or NZQA qualification or other relevant qualification as approved by FMANZ. Route (d) Three years general managerial experience in addition to five years' experience in FM in a management role.	Please submit CV, job description and qualification certificate as relevant. Certified	Individual members need to satisfy the Board they have a level of knowledge, skill, experience and qualifications that is sufficient to award Certified Membership based on the FMANZ Professional Competencies Framework. Fellow	Awarded by the FMANZ Board for significant contribution to FMANZ.	Please complete the Fellow nomination form. 240 points are required as per the awards grading spreadsheet.	FFMANZ
