


Kia ora ,

Information for Government Tenders

If you're looking to tender for government work, here are a couple of websites to check out. [This link](#) will take you to an overview of the All of Government Construction Consultancy Services (AoG CCS) panel, managed by the Ministry of Business, Innovation and Employment. Open for applications, the AoG CCS panel lowers the barriers for providers to provide construction-related consultancy services to government, and simplifies how agencies conduct their procurement processes. Note there is a category for Building and Facility Construction and Maintenance Services. [Marketplace](#) is the digital platform that supports the government procurement agency. It has information for suppliers on how they can register their details with the government agencies that are procuring products and services.


