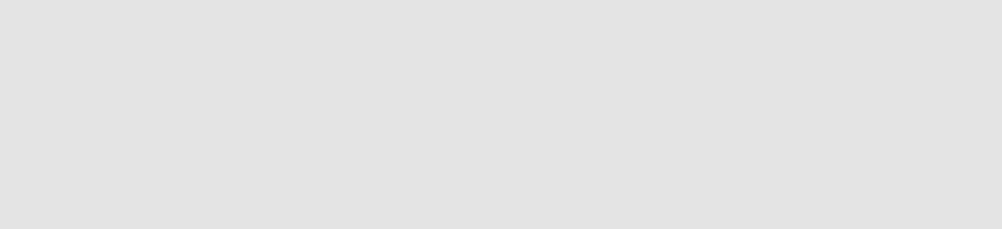


On-Going Maintenance - Airborne contaminants, including salt deposits, which settle on the paint film can attack the surface and cause premature breakdown. Cleaning of exterior paintwork on an annual basis is recommended to help maintain the fresh appearance of paintwork and also prolong its lifespan. Areas that are not rain-washed (ie canopy areas & soffits etc) require particular attention as contaminants can remain permanently on the surface and accelerate issues without regular cleaning. Substrate issues can also easily adversely affect a paint coating (ie timber moving, splitting etc) therefore regular maintenance to address issues assists with prolonging the lifespan.

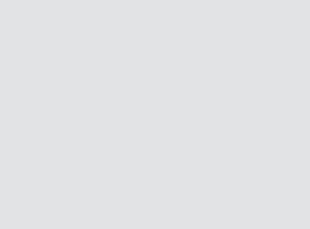
Look out for - Paint and substrate issues early on. Addressing them sooner rather than later in a maintenance programme will significantly prolong the life of a paint coating and keep your buildings looking great.

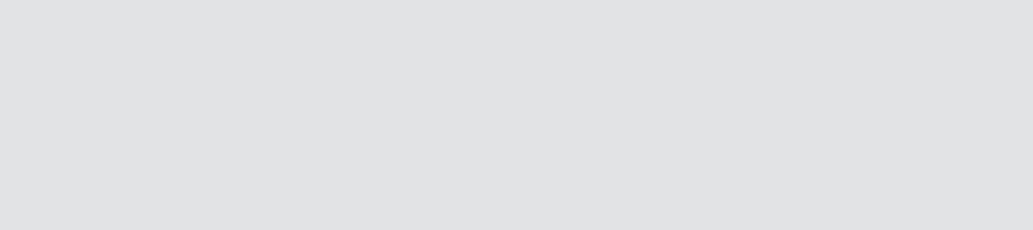
