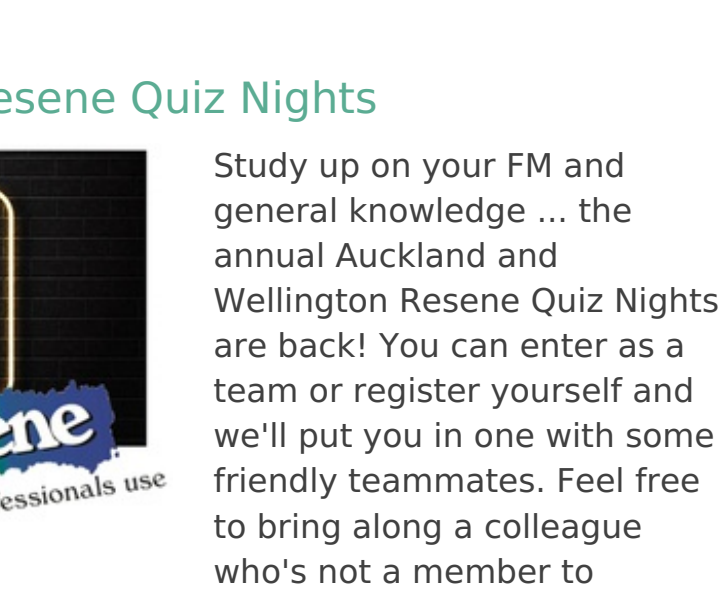
**FM Lunch & Learn - Massey's FM Qualifications**

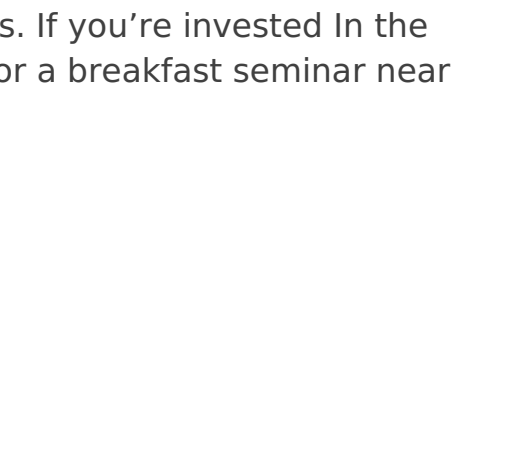
**Auckland & Wellington Resene Quiz Nights**

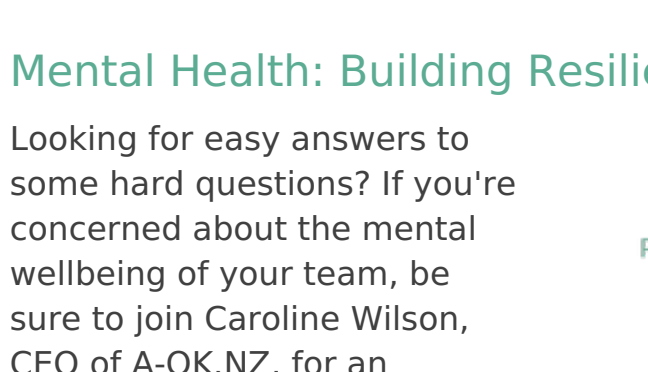

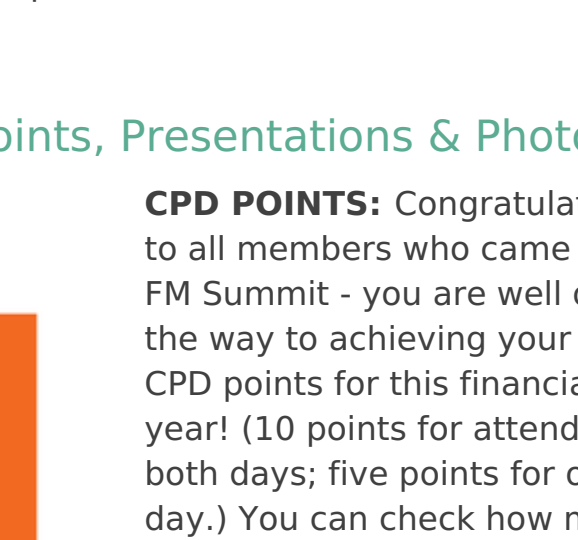

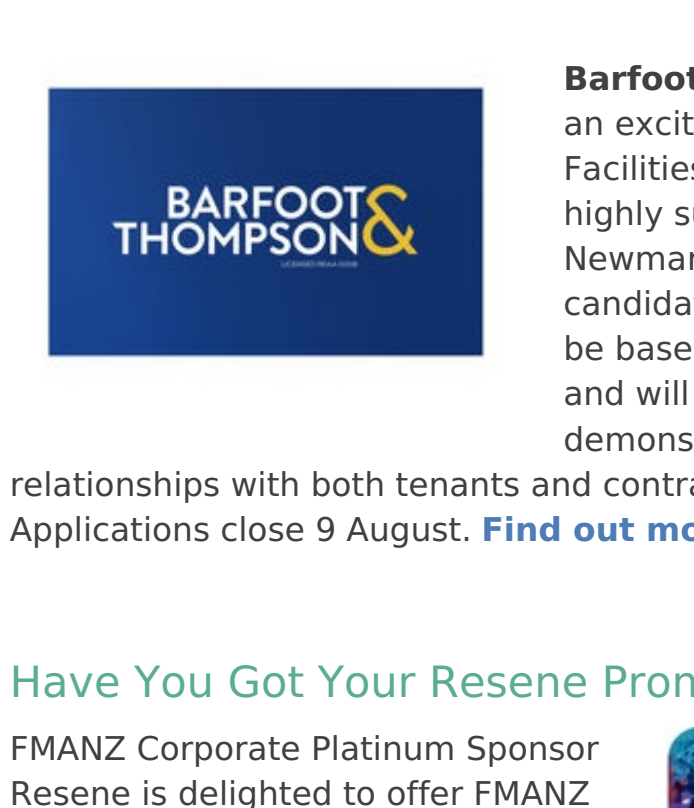

**FM Summit Wrap-Up: CPD Points, Presentations & Photos**



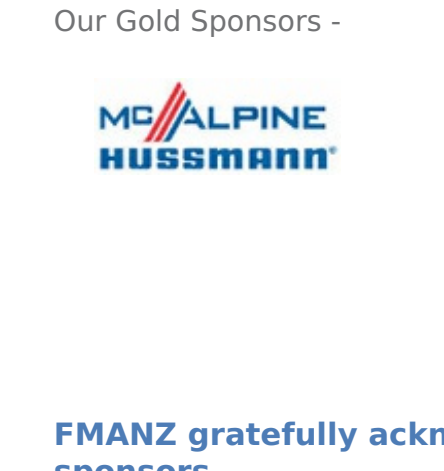

(10 points for attending both days; five points for one day.) You can check how many points you've accrued at any time by logging in to the **online member portal** and clicking the 'Your CPD' tab. If you've forgotten your password, click 'Forgot Password?' to reset.
