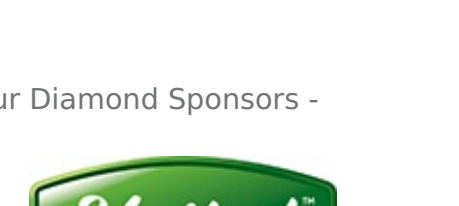
Sprinklered buildings and change of tenant, usage and storage - A change of building use or storage may also mean the sprinkler system has to change in order to continue to

meet compliance requirements. Examples of changes that could impact the sprinkler system are racking and storage heights, and changes in what is being stored i.e. going from low combustible goods to high combustible goods.

To avoid surprises and possibly significant costs, Argus recommends speaking with your Fire Systems Service Provider before the lease is signed. They will be able to advise as to what impact the changes (in tenant, usage and storage) will have on the sprinkler system, and what this could mean financially. Note: Having new occupants fill out a Form 4a storage declaration will clearly document and determine if the type of goods and storage intention still sit within the existing design parameters of the fire sprinkler system.

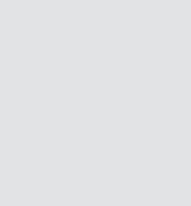
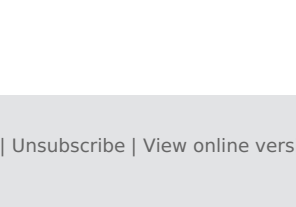
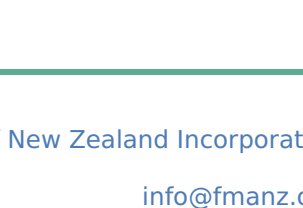
