Student	Open to full-time secondary or tertiary students with an interest in FM as a possible career. Evidence of full-time study is required.	No assessment required.	
Graduate	To be eligible for Graduate Membership, you must have completed a degree or diploma program at a recognised tertiary institution. Proof of completion of studies must be provided. You are entitled to graduate membership for the first two years of your facilities management career.	No assessment required.	
Affiliate	Entry level grade. Suitable for newcomers to FM, suppliers working within the industry, or anyone with an interest in the FM industry who is not pursuing professional development or qualifications as a practising facilities manager. Previous experience in facilities management is not required.	No assessment required.	
Associate	Route (a): You have worked in FM for two years. Route (b): You have worked in FM for one year and hold an FM-related qualification at NZQA Level 4.	Please submit CV and qualification certificate as relevant.	AFMANZ
Professional	Route (a): You have three years experience in management plus two years in FM as well as an NZQA L5 diploma; or at least one year's experience in management and one year in FM plus an NZQA L6 degree. Route (b): You have three years management experience plus two years in FM plus an FM qualification or NZQA qualification as recognised by FMANZ. Route (c): You have three years management experience plus two years in FM plus another relevant qualification. Route (d): You have three years experience in management plus five years of FM management experience.	Please submit CV, job description and qualification certificate as relevant.	PFMANZ
Certified	Individual members need to satisfy the Board. They have a level of knowledge, skill, experience and qualifications that is sufficient to award Certified Membership based on the FMANZ Professional Competencies Framework.	Please complete the Certified application form and submit along with the required supporting documentation.	CFMANZ
Fellow	Awarded by the FMANZ Board in recognition of a member's significant contribution to FMANZ.	Candidates are identified by the Chief Executive and approved by the Awards Committee and Board.	FFMANZ
Retired	Open to individuals over the age of 65 who have officially retired from facilities management, but have an ongoing interest in the industry.	No assessment required.	Retired members can use the post-nominal for their membership status at the time of retirement, followed by (Retired).
